Interestingly enough, about 2 Million people in the UK own Hearing Aids, and at least another 3 Million people have hearing difficulties in everyday life and are likely to benefit from a hearing aid.

The Disability Discrimination Act 1995 makes it unlawful to discriminate on the grounds of disability when providing services, facilities, goods or employment. As of 1st October 1999 Part 3 of the Act will stipulate that it is the duty of a service provider to make reasonable adjustments. A service provider may have to provide an Auxiliary Aid or Service if it would enable (or make it easier for) disabled people to make use of their goods, facilities or services.

It is also a Requirement under the Building Regulations 1991 to Provide Access and Facilities for Disabled people, particularly "Aids to Communication", and as such Deaf & Hard of Hearing People could be denied access to your building.
